TORNADO BASICS

LEARN THE TERMINOLOGY

The National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration issues three types of advisories when weather conditions meet certain criteria:



TORNADO WARNING

A tornado has been spotted or indicated by weather radar, meaning a tornado is occurring or expected soon.

TAKE ACTION

There is imminent danger to life and property. Immediately seek refuge in the safest location possible.

TORNADO WATCH



Weather conditions could lead to the formation of severe storms and tornadoes.

BE PREPARED: Know your safe location. Be ready to act quickly if a Warning is issued or you suspect a tornado is approaching.

TORNADO EMERGENCY



An exceedingly rare situation with a severe threat to human life and catastrophic damage due to a confirmed violent tornado.

TAKE ACTION: There is imminent danger to life and property. Immediately seek refuge in the safest location possible.

GET READY AHEAD OF TIME

Gather these supplies to prepare for a potential threat:



HELMETS
(such as bike, motorcycle, athletic) for every member of the family



STURDY SHOES,
to safely walk through glass and debris



FIRST AID KIT,
with extra prescription and nonprescription medications



Battery-powered **FLASHLIGHT** and extra batteries



Battery-powered **RADIO,** weather radio



FOOD ITEMS containing protein (nuts and energy bars), canned food, manual can opener



BOTTLED WATER for each person and pet



ID such as driver's license; **CASH** and **CREDIT CARDS**



CELLPHONE CHARGERS



BABY SUPPLIES, if a small child is in the household



Copy of family **emergency and COMMUNICATION PLAN**

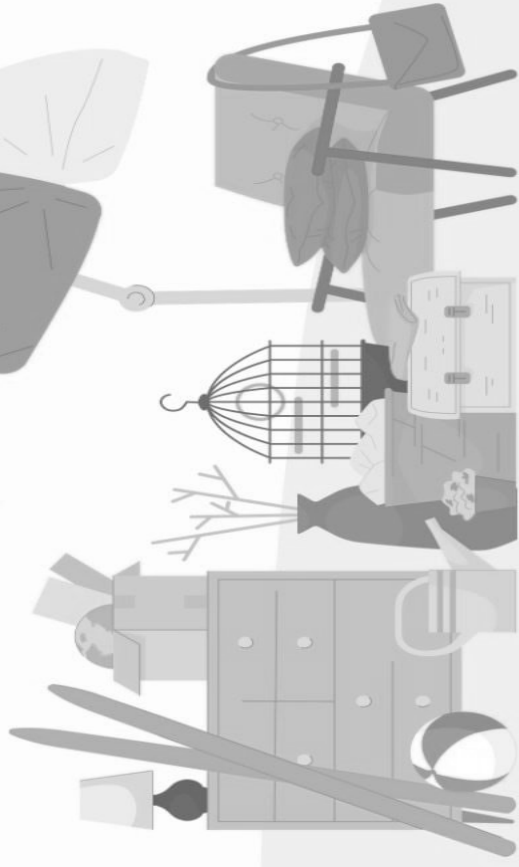
