MINUTES, April 24, 2025

The Granby Board of Aldermen held a Public Hearing regarding the City's 2020 sewer project for renovation of the existing sewer treatment facility including construction of a new peak flow detention basin as well as major upgrades to the existing primary lift station. After answering council's questions regarding the installation of required fencing, Bobbi White moved to approve the request; Kristi McGehee seconded the motion. The Bills to Pay/Balances on Hand report was not available

After a lengthy discussion regarding the cost of mowing the cemetery, who is responsible for mowing, and how to fund the expense, Bobbi White moved that a \$100 Plot Marking Fee and a \$300 Perpetual Care Fee be added to the current fees; Doreen Clouse seconded the motion. Doreen Clouse moved to change ordinance verbiage regarding interment of cremains at the cemetery; Bobbi White seconded the motion. Voting aye: Bob Brooks, Doreen Clouse, Kristy McGehee, and Bobbi White. Voting nay: None. Motion carried: 4-0.

Lawna Price provided an update on the remaining ARPA Funds and their availability for use by the City.

There was a discussion regarding a Job Description for the open maintenance position.
